A RESOLUTION SETTING OUT THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE USE OF EFFLUENT METERS IN LIEU OF WATER METERS BY COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES CONNECTED TO THE JAKES CREEK TRAIL WASTEWATER PLANT

SECTION ONE: The User Charge Ordinance Number 05-09 Article 4 Section 2 reads as follows: "For industrial and commercial contributors, user charges shall be based on water used during the current month. If a commercial or industrial contributor has a consumptive use of water, or in some other manner uses water which is not returned to the wastewater collection system, the user charge for that contributor may be based on wastewater meter(s) or separate water meter(s) installed and maintained at the contributor's expense, and in a manner acceptable to the Village of Indian Point."

SECTION TWO: Any industrial or commercial user that opts to install a wastewater meter (a/k/a effluent meter) pursuant to the User Charge Ordinance shall be responsible for all installation and operations and maintenance costs. In addition, said user shall be responsible for any replacement or repair costs so long as the property of record is connected to any Village-owned wastewater treatment plant. The effluent meter must be installed pursuant to the specifications of the project engineer and must be inspected by the project engineer before the property of record can be connected.

SECTION THREE: Any industrial or commercial user that opts to install a wastewater meter (a/k/a effluent meter) shall do so within five (5) working days of notification by the Board of Public Works that the property of record is scheduled to be connected to the wastewater plant. If the user fails to install the meter within the allocated period of time, the Board of Public Works may install a water meter and use the readings from the water meter to calculate the monthly user charges. Once a water meter is installed, a user will not be allowed to install an effluent meter at a later date without permission from the Board of Public Works.

SECTION FOUR: The Board of Public Works shall set an effluent meter fee, and any industrial or commercial user that opts to install a wastewater meter (a/k/a effluent meter) is required to pay this fee in addition to any user fees. This effluent meter fee will be added to the monthly bill and considered part of the bill for purposes of collection. This fee covers the administrative costs of manually reading the effluent meters and calculating the monthly user charges.
